Do you consider your horse "broke"?

Whether you ride English or Western, for pleasure or competition, come and learn the 10 basic moves that are the foundation to everything else you will do with your horse. If buying a horse, evaluating the horse's ability to do these moves is essential to understanding how "broke" the horse is and how much more training will be needed. Jody will teach you how to evaluate and train your horse to do these moves. Get tips on working with your horse to establish a good foundation no matter the breed or discipline. In addition, bring your questions that night to Jody on any other horse training concerns that you might have.

Jody Cunningham has over 30 years of personal experience working with horses. Growing up in New Mexico, Jody started with his first horse at age seven and showed extensively in the arena winning numerous awards and championships. His love for the horse has taken him to the mountains of New Mexico and Colorado guiding riders, shoeing horses and training colts. He has managed ranches in Texas, training their horses, designing equine facilities and more. Jody practices a rare form of horsemanship that combines practical, logical techniques of communicating and training a horse with heartfelt understanding and empathy. He loves to share his knowledge with people who want to learn to how to communicate and work together with their horse. The training methods revolve around the natural instincts of the horse. Jody says, "It is all about getting the human to think more like a horse". Once the human changes a whole new world will open up to them.
